
#### 1.1 Introduction

Students' feedback for the year 2021-22was conducted on 600 samples, including students from all three streams (B.A., B.Sc. and B. Com) selected on the basis of simple random sampling. Thequestionnaire for the feedback has been framed on the basis of NAAC guidelines. The objective of student's feedback was to measure the student's level of satisfaction on their experiences with regards to curriculum, teaching-learning, administration and infrastructure. The survey was conducted during odd semester through offline mode. Analysis and interpretation of the data obtained are presented below;

**Gender-Wise Distribution** 






### 1.2.2. Students Representation from Different Streams
































