7.1.1 Annual gender sensitization action plan

Once in every four months in a year, the Gender Sensitization Unit will conduct programmes, workshops, field survey and awareness campaigns in the college and the society at large.

The college has an active Gender Sensitization Unit comprising of Principal, Vice – Principal and senior faculties of the college. In case of any complaints, the matter is dealt in a proper manner where evidences, witnesses and other reliable sources are properly scrutinized so that the complainant and the accused are authenticated before any disciplinary measure is taken. The college has collaborated with doctors of the district hospital and lawyers from the District and Sessions courts to help and provide proper professional counselling and related assistance. 
