Earth Day April 22

Webinar on COP2 (2 November 2022)

Future Earth Global Secretariat Hub South East Asia organised an hour long webinar on the upcoming "Roadmap to United Nations Framework Convention on climate change Conference of Parties (COP27),2022". The Speaker of the day Adheesh S. Rao highlighted on the role and objectives of COP (Conference of Parties) which is the highest decision-making body of UNCCC (United Nations Climate Change Conference).The member countries of COP resolved that the global average temperature should decline by 1.5 degree Celsius by 2050. This objective should be achieved within a time frame sufficient to allow ecosystems to adapt naturally to climate change, to ensure that food production is not threatened and to enable economic development to proceed in a sustainable manner.Dr. A. S. Rao also highlighted the previous COP meetings by UNCCC. The followings were the conclusions of previous COP meetings:

COP26 on 13 December 2021: The package of decisions consists of a range of agreed items, including strengthened efforts to build resilience to climate change, to curb greenhouse gas emissions and to provide the necessary finances for both. For the first time, nations are called upon to phase down unabated coal power and inefficient subsidies for fossil fuels.

COP25 on 13 December 2019: The UN's Environment Programme says that hitting the 1.5 degree Celsius target requires a cut in GHG (Green house gasses) emissions of 7.6 percent each year between 2020 and 2030. Climate Action, has had significant success in engaging some of the world's largest emitters of GHGs to commit to net zero emissions policies.

COP 24 on 14 December 2018: The UN Climate Change Conference concluded with the guidance on the content and format of NDCs (Nationally Determined Contributions), including a summary for regular reporting, creating transparency and accountability, with common rules for measuring and reporting of greenhouse gas emissions.

World Environment Day June 5

i. recognize that education is a public service and strive to keep the public informed of the educational programmes which are being provided.

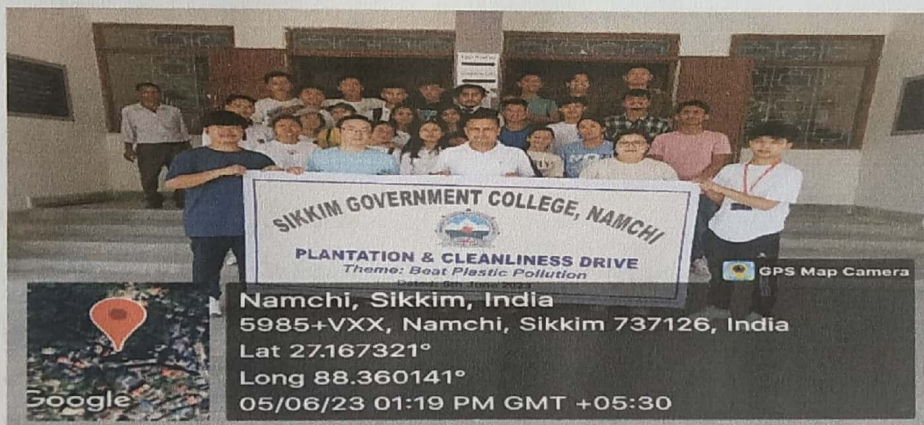
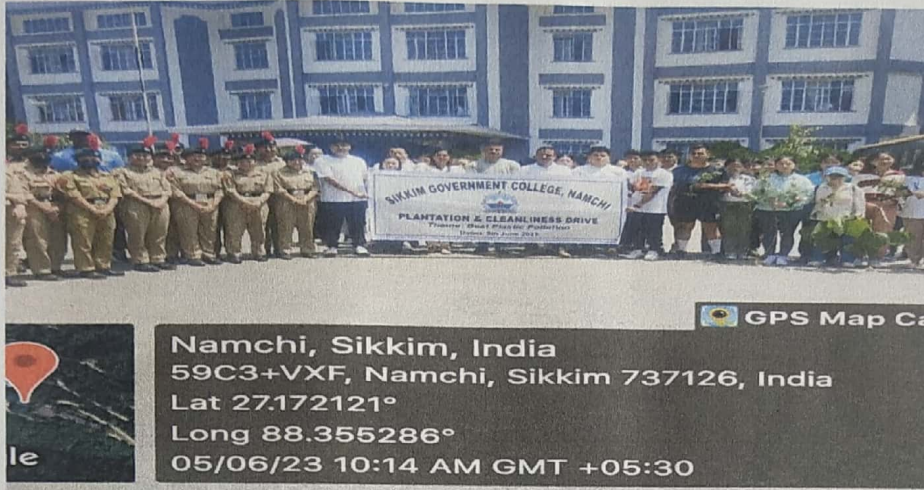
ii. work to improve education in the community and strengthen the community's moral and intellectual life.

iii. be aware of social and economical problems and take part in such activities as would be conducive to the progress of society and hence the country as a whole.

iv. perform the duties of citizenship, participate in community activities and shoulder responsibilities of public office.

v. refrain from taking part in or subscribing to or assisting in any way, activities which tend to promote feeling of hatred or enmity among different communities, relations or linguistic groups but actively work for National Integration.

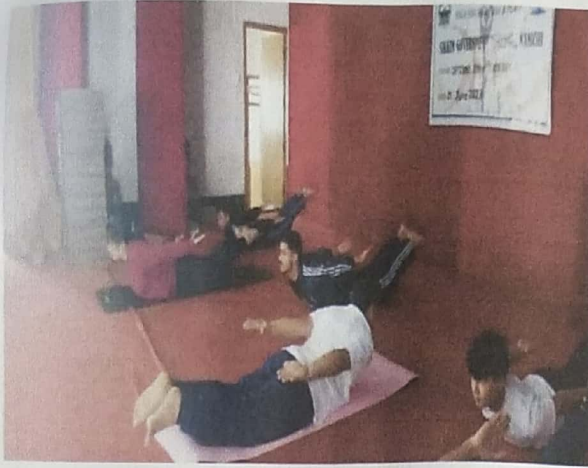


International Day of Yoga June 21
