For the Period of 2018 -2023, the programs organized are as follows:

2018:

Awareness Programme on Gender Issues was held on 27/09/2018 for the 4th and 6th-semester students from Humanities Commerce and Science streams. The total number of participants were 42 students, with 26 females and 16 male students.

2019:

Programme on Legal Aspects on Molestation and Child Abuse was conducted on 9/05/2019. Students of all streams attended the programme with a presence of 76 female and 29 male students.

On 29/08/2019 the Gender Sensitisation Unit organised a 2 days programme on Self Defence for Girls. The programme concluded successfully on 30/08/2019. The total number of girl students who participated in the programme was 180. Since the programme was focused completely on girls, there was no male participation.

A programme titled, 'Counselling on Mental Health', was conducted on 27/09/2019. The programme also included issues related to gender equality and harassment in our society. The students from all disciplines attended the programme. A total of 129 students attended the programme where 87 students were females and 42 were male students.

On 9/10/2019 Awareness programme was conducted by the Gender Sensitisation Unit (College unit) at Sikkim Govt. College, Namchi. Dr. Genevive Syangbo, Assistant professor, SCERT presented a paper on "Sexual Harassment at work place". The programme was attended by the Principal Dr. Parshuram Poudyal, teaching faculty, non-teaching staff and students of Ist, IIIrd to Vth semester.

2020:

10 July, 2020: Sikkim Government College, Namchi students shared their journey as young women achievers to promote ideas on feminism in the society. More precisely, to overcome the myth that women cannot do it. The programme was organized by Café the Twins.



2021:

The Gender Sensitization Unit Sikkim Government College, Namchi organized an online program on "Gender Equality" for the students on 2021. The Convenor of the Gender Sensitization Unit highlighted the need to bring awareness among the students about the basic concepts of gender stereotypes, end violence against girls & women, and Implementation of POSCO Act. The Gender Sensitization Unit along with the members of the Discipline Committee also acts as the Grievance Redressal Body for any harassment-related issues. The college also provides a Girls Common Room facility as a recreation space for the students.

On the occasion of International Women's Day on 08/03/2021, students of Sikkim Government College, Kamrang distributed edibles goods (fruits, juice and biscuits) to the patients of Namchi Govt Hospital.



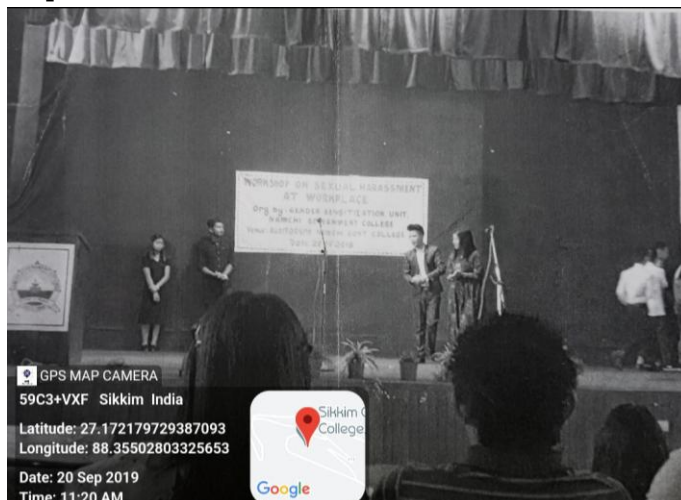
